Designed for young campers, Mini Camp is the perfect introduction to Tall Timber for your child. This safe, fun, structured, low-key camp provides an opportunity to experience nature, campfires, crafts, games, silliness, Bible stories, and 2 nights in your cabin. Mini campers and our friendly staff are the only ones at Tall Timber during your stay, intentionally creating an encouraging atmosphere for our newest guests. If your child is not quite ready to leave the nest for two nights without you, we have limited space for parents to join for an extra fee. This camp is shorter, more structured, less crowded, and geared toward younger campers. It is recommended for first-time campers or those still a bit hesitant to leave home for too long.
