## Adventure Trips: ages 13-15

A CRS raft trip is an unforgettable adventure! Our rafters and their leaders find excitement on a weeklong expedition to the Smokey Mountains spending the week unplugged, camping out and connecting with God and each other while taking on challenges that require true teamwork.

**Boys Rafting Adventure:** experience adventure through a high ropes course, Nantahala, Chattooga, and Ocoee Rivers.

**Girls Combined Adventure:** grow through the challenges of a high ropes course, Chattooga III, duckies on the Nantahala, and the Ocoee river.
