The good news is that there are practical ways to spot telltale signs of an abuser and, even better, to help avoid being targeted in the first place. "Nobody is saying, 'Come on in, predators,' " Norris says. "But there's a difference between opposition to abuse *in concept* and having preventative, proactive, protective initiatives in place."

A meaningful screening process involves an effective application process, checking references and interviewing candidates with pointed questions designed to determine whether they're at risk of being an abuser.
