BART HADDER retired in 2015 where he served as Program Director at the M.J. Murdock Charitable Trust, Vancouver, Wash.

Bart has specialized in evaluating the overall organizational health of Christian camps and conference centers, Christian schools, other Christian ministries, and numerous other youth development focused non-profit organizations. The outcome of this analysis has been to determine an organization's readiness and capacity to complete and sustain a capital project or program expansion, thus allowing the Trustees of the Murdock Trust to make a well informed decision regarding request for grant support.

He has worked with organizations with annual budgets ranging from less than \$100K to multiple millions, and with staff sizes ranging from a few volunteers to several hundred employees. Bart has counseled many organizations on how to approach a foundation and conducted workshops on strategies for successful grant seeking at regional and national conferences.

After serving as a program director for the M.J. Murdock Charitable Trust, in Vancouver, Washington, for 14 years, Bart retired in July 2015. Prior to joining the Murdock Trust, Bart's first career of 27 years involved serving as a science teacher both at the middle and high school levels and as the K-12 science coordinator for a large suburban school district in the Portland, Oregon area.

Bart began his undergraduate studies at Northwest Nazarene College and graduated with his BA from the University of Washington in biology. He later received his master's degree in biology education from Portland State University.

During this third-third season of life, Bart is pursuing the opportunities God is providing to capitalize on the knowledge gained from his past experiences to help advance Christian ministries such as Christian camping.

Bart and his wife, Jackie, have two grown children and one grandchild (so far) and live in the Vancouver, Washington area.
