
WHY SOUTHEAST AK?

WHAT DOES A COUNSELOR DO?

Counselors are responsible for staying in a cabin with 7-10 campers and 1 co-counselor each week, making sure campers have a fun and safe week, and sharing the Gospel with them! You'll take your campers to chapel twice each day and lead discussions with them; play field games and run activity stations like the zipline and canoeing; participate in songs and fun events like Paint War; help with support services during your weeks on workstaff; and much more!

WHAT WILL IT TAKE?

13 weeks (mid-May to early August) This includes staff orientation, 9 weeks of summer camp, a mid-summer Sabbath week for rest and excursions, and end-of-summer debrief.
