

Remote and rugged, the Wilderness Ranch valley was first homesteaded in the early 20th century by the Wills family who operated a profitable trout hatchery and cabin rentals to fishermen. In the early 1970s, Will and Betty Wyatt purchased the property as a family retreat. Following a campfire conversation with Bob Mitchell (Young Life president at the time), the Wyatts were led to consider the property for Young Life to use as a backpacking ministry. Bob Mitchell and the Wyatts knew Young Life should be using this tool to draw high school kids closer to Christ. The first Young Life backpackers came to Wilderness Ranch in 1973, and the Wyatts turned over the property to Young Life completely in 1978. The 80 acres, complete with a dazzling lake, nestled in a beautiful valley in the San Juan mountains, provide the signature location for Wilderness Ranch. In the summers since, thousands of high school friends have been exposed to Jesus Christ and a deeper relationship with Him through the wonders of a week in God's creation, with gifted leaders who are passionate about connecting high school students to Jesus Christ

IMPACT

Wilderness Ranch seeks to create a less distracted space for people to meet Jesus Christ and grow in their faith through a guided wilderness adventure. Through relationships and asking questions, we want to offer constructive, hopeful, God-centered insights to the core issues of identity, belonging and purpose. Recent data from multiple Young Life areas showed that of high school students that went to outreach camp only, 33% were following Jesus three to five years later. Of those that also went to Wilderness Ranch, that number increased to 92%!
