



The grounds consist of 13 teepees housing 8-12 campers and a counselor in each teepee. A 5 unit motel and 2 cabins house our staff, medical office and infirmary. A large outdoor chapel, gazebo, craft house, dining hall with kitchen, shower house, and trading post for snacks are used by the campers for daily activities. Five RV hookups are available for staff use as well as for use by rental groups, and folks who attend our annual family retreat.



Family Retreat

This retreat is held every Labor Day weekend Friday through Sunday.

Families from all over gather for fellowship, family activities, recreation opportunities, daily family devotions, and Worship.



Snow Camps

Located 7.5 miles south of the Rifle city limits on West Mamm Creek, **Teepee Bible Camp** is situated on a lovely, wooded, 40-acre tract just 3 miles from the White River National Forest. It is a non-profit, Bible-based, non-denominational camp incorporated by the State of Colorado.

All boys and girls ages 7-17 are accepted regardless of race, national origin, or denominational affiliation. We believe that a group camping experience should be included in the life of every boy and girl.

The camp is financed solely by the gifts of God's people who have a love for boys and girls. Camp fees are affordable for all.



Summer camps are conducted on a theme of tribal life and Native American lore. Bible Study and worship, recreation, Gaga Ball, crafts, hiking, group games, tepee competition, and campfire activities are part of each camp's program. Other activities are pictured in this brochure and on our website.

During camps our infirmary is staffed 24 hours a day with a qualified medical person. We are located approximately 9 miles from hospital and medical services in Rifle.



The most important point of our program is the teaching of the Word of God by competent, qualified teachers. We give campers tools to help them daily connect with God and enable them to cope with the pressures of life. Every camper is given the opportunity to claim Christ as their Savior and Lord.



Compassionate counselors are provided with a dedicated staff to meet the needs of each child spiritually, physically, mentally, and socially. All adult Staff are background checked and trained by Certified Counselors and knowledgeable staff.

A free training camp for workers age 14-18 is held in mid-June to train workers for camp leadership. Graduates of this training are recruited to help in regular camps as Counselors, Counselors-In-Training, and Jr. Staff.

Teen Retreats

In fall, Girls age 12-18 can enjoy a weekend of activities to enhance their natural beauty and physical strength. Group studies encourage spiritual growth and identity through Jesus Christ. A candlelight dinner is a highlight of the weekend.



In Spring, Guys age 12-18 can enjoy a weekend of indoor and outdoor sports. Group studies encourage self-discipline and spiritual growth. Campfires and a smoke house dinner are highlights of the weekend.
