Upon receipt of your registration, you will be sent an email confirmation detailing what to bring (besides swimsuits!), specific directions to the camp, and when the drop off and pick up times will be for your camp. All week long camps will start at 5:00pm on the first day.

Bingle Camp Policies

Refund Policy: Refunds (less deposit) will be given if cancellation is made at least 14 days prior to the first day of camp.

Balance of Fee: If you choose to submit a deposit of \$50 to reserve your space at camp, the balance is due by the start of your camp.

Scholarship: If you are in need of financial assistance, we have a limited scholarship fund. Please email or call the office at (907) 479-0562 for a scholarship form. You will be required to submit a registration form along with a scholarship form and the \$50 deposit to be considered for a scholarship. Please apply early!

Attendance Policy: Each parent or guardian sending a camper to Bingle Camp must clearly intend that the camper will remain on camp premises for the duration of the camp. For the sake of campers and staff, it is the policy of Bingle Camp that campers not be removed from the camp by a parent or guardian and returned later to complete the camp without prior permission from our director.
