# WHY SUMMER CAMP?

## Camp Grows Faith

God uses the outdoor setting of creation along with summer staff to offer unique ways to grow in faith, hope, love, grace, and independence within a Christian community.



## Camp Provides Connections

The natural setting of camp is the perfect place to unplug from technology and daily routines in order to reconnect with God and with others. Campers will experience living with peers and interacting face-to-face with others.

## Camp Prepares Leaders

Campers are given opportunities to learn to positively influence their peers through daily living, playing together, working as a team to accomplish a goal, and practicing communication skills while having fun.



## Camp Changes Lives

Camp creates an environment that encourages participation and creates a space where campers can step outside their Comfort Zones into their Stretch Zones. They do this by determining their own level of involvement in any given activity, trying new things or setting goals for themselves.

# LOMIK CAMP EXPERIENCES

LOMIK offers residential Christian camp experiences where relationships with God and one another are explored at each of our three sites.

Campers experience a wide variety of age appropriate activities in small and large groups. Bible study, games, hiking, swimming, arts & crafts, devotions, worship, campfires, and music play a part in the excitement of a week at camp.

Summer programs are staffed by fun, enthusiastic, college-aged counselors who love working with kids, come highly recommended, and have positive attitudes towards life. Their Christian faith plays a role in their everyday lives. Their words and actions show they use good judgement in the care of themselves and others.

All camps are full weeks, Sunday through Friday, except for Pilgrim Camp, Grandparent Camp, and Staff Alumni Camp which are Sunday through Wednesday (\*\*).

# CAMPERS GRADES 1-3

**For Campers entering Grades 1-3**

**Registration closes 2 weeks prior to the start of each camp session.**

**Pilgrim Camp** is a great way to introduce your child to the joy of camp and to experience the love of God while being surrounded by nature. Sunday through Wednesday is packed full of faith-filled fun with new friends. Activities include Bible study, music, arts & crafts, games, swimming, and campfires.

**Super-Pilgrim** is a Sunday through Friday option for those Pilgrims who are ready for full week away from home while experiencing new things in a safe and encouraging environment.



# GRANDPARENT CAMP

**For Grandparents Sunday through Wednesday**

**Registration closes 2 weeks prior to the start of each camp session.**

**Grandparent Camp** runs in conjunction with select Pilgrim Camp weeks. Grandparents stay in the adult-friendly retreat facilities, while the campers stay in camper cabins with LOMIK staff. Grandparents enjoy a relaxing Sunday through Wednesday in a Christian camp environment. Join in meals and camp fun with grandchildren or spend time in nature. # CAMPERS GRADES 1-6

**For Campers entering Grades 1-6**

**Spaces are limited. Registration Closes May 27, 2024.**

**Riding into God's Grace Camp** in addition to swimming, campfires, Bible studies, and field games, campers will travel off-site and spend a day at a Horse Camp.

Campers will take part in general horse care, how to saddle, bridle, and ride along with learning about the traits of perseverance, integrity, humility, and teamwork.

# CAMPERS GRADES 3-6

**For Campers entering Grades 3-6**

**Spaces are limited and fill up quickly.**

**Registration closes 2 weeks prior to camp sessions or when capacity is reached.**

**Reading Camp** is designed to improve reading skills for campers recommended by their teachers. Campers will unplug from screens, play in nature, and gain new reading skills. Small group learning led by volunteer teachers each morning. Remainder of the day is filled with field games, songs, crafts, hiking, swimming, campfires & chapel. There is Christian element in our camp programming. *Teacher referral and test scores are requested prior to camp.*

# CAMPERS AGES 8-16

**Registration closes July 1, 2024.**

**Foundation for Art & Music in Education (FAME) Camp** is for creative and artistic students ages 8-16. This camp presents the FAME cultural focus in dance, drama, music, and art. Campers will further their current artistic study and participate in an artist youth community led by an outstanding faculty of arts educators. Nightly talent sharing provides performance fun and camaraderie. Classes include:

## CAMPERS GRADES 4-6

**For Campers entering Grades 4-6**

**Registration closes 2 weeks prior to the start of each camp session.**

**Pioneer Camp** is a week filled with fun, interactive, Christ-centered activities. Campers unplug from screens and immerse themselves in nature and the love of God. They'll play outdoors in small and large groups, letting their creative skills show in crafts, music, and activities.

**Nature Navigator Camp** allows campers to explore the positive impact of time with God in nature. An intentional focus on how we can be good stewards of God's creation will be explored through games, activities, crafts, and small acts of service around camp.

**Animal Lovers Camp** is for children who love animals and want to learn about some of God's creatures. **For Campers entering Grades 5 - 10**

**Guitar & Ukulele Camp** is for those learning guitar or ukulele for the first time or seasoned players looking to improve their skills. Along with classic camp fun, campers spend four hours each day with an instructor learning camp songs and other classics. Campers should bring their own acoustic guitar or ukulele and will receive a camp song book to take home. A brief concert will be performed at the closing program on Friday.

# CAMPERS GRADES 6-9



**For Campers entering Grades 6 - 9**

**Confirmation Camp** combines 2 hours of study each day with their pastor/leader and confirmation classmates, along with all of the classic camp activities. Confirmation camp dates are determined by your local congregation, but parents register their own children.

# CAMPERS GRADES 7-9

**For Campers entering Grades 7 - 9**

**Registration closes 2 weeks prior to the start of each camp session.**

**Trailblazer Camp** is a high-energy faith-centered camp tailored to adolescents. This week is a great way for campers to grow confident in their faith while being surrounded by other believers and experiencing God in creation. Campers step away from the daily routine and engage in camp activities like Bible study, chapel, swimming, games, arts & crafts, and campfires. The focus is on building community and connecting with others face-to-face, meeting new friends and reconnecting with familiar faces.

**Trailblazer Servant Camp** is a blend of fun and service opportunities. Campers experience classic camp activities like Bible study, games, swimming, hiking, chapel, and campfires. They work alongside their counselors and adult volunteers to change lives by sharing God's love with others by serving.

**Hiking & Caving Adventure** campers, alongside their counselors, do day hikes around the 700+ acres at Lutheran Hills and enjoy classic camp activities - games, songs, and Bible study. Campers also go off-site for walking/crawling tours of caves in southern Indiana and camping at a state park. The focus of this program is exploring in God's creation while growing faith and stretching beyond their comfort zone in a safe and fun environment.

# STAFF ALUMNI CAMP



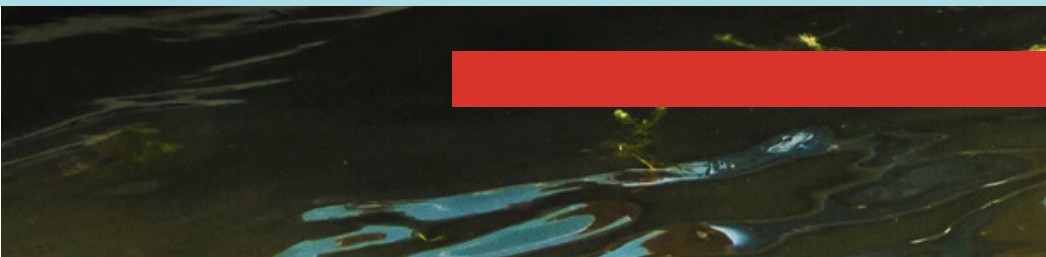
## For Staff Alumni & Their Families
