

Our four-day summer camp serves children between the ages of 7-12 who have experienced the death of a family member. Typical losses include illness, suicide, traumatic accidents, homicide and military combat. The camp is held each summer at a beautiful retreat facility in central Texas.

Weekend retreats are also available to families of children who attend summer camp. Participants meet others coping with similar losses in a nurturing and supportive environment for processing grief as a family unit. Activities assist the grief process and give families tools for moving forward without their loved one.

Our retreat is held at the beginning of the holiday season to help families maneuver the challenges this time of year may present.

Camp Agapé is a free grief support program for children. Group sessions incorporate the use of art, music, equine therapy, and play therapy in a fun and nurturing summer camp setting. Our holistic approach addresses the emotional, physical and spiritual aspects of the healing process. Camp Agapé's faith-based therapeutic program provides hope and healing to children in their time of sorrow due to the loss of a loved one.


